




INTEGRATED APPROACHES IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE-SEMINAR

USE OF INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARDS-WORKSHOP









NAAC ACCREDITATION PROCESS-WORKSHOP
