These activities helped students to understand about ' Science and Technology ' and science related concepts.






REPORT ON SWAMI VIVEKANANDA JAYANTHI

8th November 2022






YOGA DAY @ S N C E, MAHE

The programme could enable to improve the physical and mental well-being among the students instructor recommended the students integrates Yoga into daily life.






WORLD WATER DAY – AWARENESS PROGRAMME

4th February 2022



6th November 2019


Objective: To study the awareness of women about their rights and to organize awareness programs for women empowerment.

5th June 2019



11TH October 2022


